Subject:	Incorrect calendar alignment on a weekly timeframe		
Description:	<p>When a calendar is aligned on weekly time frame, the outcome for Sundays and Mondays is wrong or counter-intuitive. Every day of week (Tue-Sat) is aligned to the prior Monday. But Monday is aligned to the <code>_upcoming_</code> Monday and Sunday it is aligned to the next <code>_Saturday_</code> !</p> <p>This is what happens:</p> <p>Tue 8/4/2009 -> Mon 8/3/2009 Wed 8/5/2009 -> Mon 8/3/2009 Thu 8/6/2009 -> Mon 8/3/2009 Fri 8/7/2009 -> Mon 8/3/2009 Sat 8/8/2009 -> Mon 8/3/2009</p> <p>Mon 8/3/2009 -> Mon 8/10/2009 (was) -> Mon 8/03/2009 (now)</p> <p>Sun 8/2/2009 -> Mon 8/8/2009 (was) -> Mon 7/27/2009 (now)</p> <p>I think that Monday should be aligned to itself and Sunday should be aligned to the prior Monday. I attached a patch with the fix and updated unit tests.</p> <p>PS: I think we should be mention somewhere in the documentation that a week starts on Monday.</p>
